### Waterfowl and Fishing Packages

Within 25 minutes of Tumbleweed Lodge, the Missouri River harbors one of the best migratory flights of Canada geese and one of the top walleye/smallmouth bass fisheries in the country. In December and January the prairie skies fill with Canada geese, speckle bellies, snows and mallards. Hunting over decoys or pass shooting the bluffs are the methods to our success. The waterfowl option is an add-on at \$395/day plus applicable license fees. For those intrigued by a Cast and Blast, add a day of fishing to your package for \$895/day plus applicable license fees. Walleye and smallmouth bass are the primary target, but northern pike and crappie add to the excitement from mid-September to mid-October.
